Topic/Idea: Teamwork Meeting Idea

Goal/Objective: To show students effectiveness of teamwork

Materials needed: 4 Hula Hoops, Capri Suns, and chips

Procedures/Guidelines/Instructions:

At your meeting, begin by asking students to define teamwork and what makes a person a good team player.

Go outside (on a pretty day) and break into two teams, some can be boys versus girls. Each team will be given two hula hoops. Groups will stand in a circle and hold hands. They will then pass the hula hoop to each other without dropping hands. It gets difficult when the hula hoops meet. Encouragement of team members is vital.

After the groups have found a winner, discuss the results of their teamwork while enjoying some snacks.
